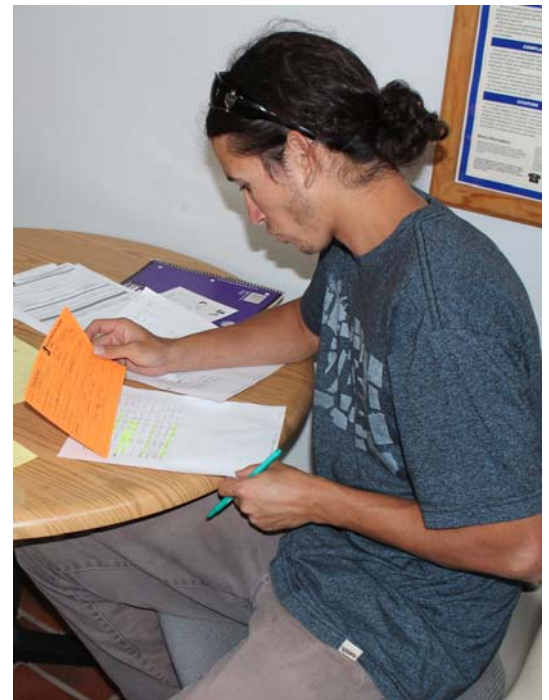
One of the goals is to increase the number of graduates from northeastern New Mexico in the STEM area.
