LCC to provide free flu shots

Luna Community College, along with the New Mexico Public Health Department and San Miguel County will be providing a free flu shot clinic at the LCC Allied Health Atrium (nursing department) located on the northwest part of campus.

Luna Community College will be hosting two dates for the flu shot clinic, the first from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Friday, Oct. 25 and the second from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Friday, Nov. 1.

Luna Community College nursing students will administer the shots with supervision from LCC Nursing Faculty.
