Luna Community College Accelerate students will be attending a workshop on Friday, Oct. 4 in Taos. Luna Community College will be joined by students from six other northern New Mexico institutions of higher education. The workshop will take place at the Taos Country Club.

The workshop, entitled "Unleashing Your Super Powers" will help students identify their unique strengths, hone their networking abilities, and build professional readiness skills.

The Accelerate Technical Training and Job Placement Program will bring 80 students together for a four hour workshop.
