on your part. That is what they are here for. They live to help you, not make things hard on you. You can also take a few minutes to talk with your instructor before or after class. Ask a question on the material or check on your progress in the course. This will also make you more comfortable to ask for help when you really need it.

Stay up to date with your work – Easier said than done; however, it is critical. You need to do each assignment before you attend the next class. If you get behind in your reading, you may never have time to catch up. The workload in college just increases as the semester progresses.

Be Self disciplined – know your personal responsibilities such as manage your time, keep a calendar, schedule in a study time, stay organized with your lecture notes and handouts, review your notes, eat healthy, get enough rest, get to know your college catalogue, and meet college deadlines. These are all things you can do to help succeed during the semester. The catch is that no one will tell you to do these things. You have to be self disciplined.

A lot of students run into problems in college for reasons that have nothing to do with their ability to handle the academics. They get into trouble because they are not prepared for the numerous responsibilities that have suddenly been thrust upon them. In other words, you don't have to be "a brain" to succeed in college; you have to have the persistence and determination. What will help you carry out these five suggestions is the persistence and what gives you the persistence is remembering why you are here. An old Chinese proverb states, "Teachers open the door, you enter by yourself."

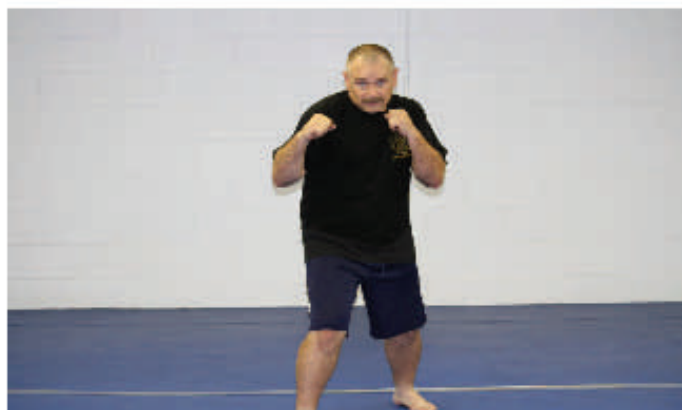

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Staying in shape important to legendary coach

Larry Archuleta impressed with LCC Wellness Center

Larry Archuleta will be 66 years next month. But the legendary baseball coach still works out as if he were 36.

Archuleta, who once played for the Los Angeles Dodgers organization, is a student at Luna Community College as he is taking a self-directed weightlifting class at the Gerald Ortega Wellness Center.

"I love it over here," says Archuleta. "It's one of the better facilities I've ever been at. The people here are friendly, the atmosphere is great and they keep the place very clean."

Because Archuleta is over 55, a semester's worth of workouts come at a price tag of only \$28. Anyone interested in registering for PE 112 and 113 on the main campus for this semester have until March 22 to do so.

"I'm a firm believer in staying fit and staying in shape," says Archuleta, who admits like many people, that he gained some weight over Christmas break. "When I was coaching, there was nothing I wouldn't ask my kids do that I wouldn't do. I would run sprints, do crunches and lift weights with them every year until I retired."

A 1965 Robertson High graduate, Archuleta was an all-state student-athlete in football and baseball. He was also an all-district player in basketball. After playing one year for John Donnelly and the Highlands University baseball team, he was recruited to play for the Albuquerque Dukes (now the Isotopes), an AA pro team under the Dodgers back then.

"I was a shortstop and played some second base," says Archuleta.

But like many young men during that era, Archuleta was drafted to the Vietnam War.

"I was in the armed forces for two years but I never went to Vietnam, I got to play baseball for EUROSA (an all-star Army team in Europe)," says Archuleta.

After this, he was back in Vegas and earned his bachelor's and master's degree at Highlands. After a one year teaching and coaching stint at Valley Junior High in El Valle, Archuleta spent the next 24 years at Robertson.

"I loved being around young people and I didn't want them to be cheated in life," says Archuleta. "I made sure I taught them everything they needed to be the best they could be and to believe they could compete with anyone."

His philosophy worked as his teams won five district championship and were a regular at the state tournament. His team's highest finish was third in 1989.

And the legendary coach continues to compete—with his workouts.

"The motivational factor has to be within you," says Archuleta. "You have to sacrifice the time and diet; it's not an easy thing. As you get older you treasure life a little more and realize you have to take care of your body."

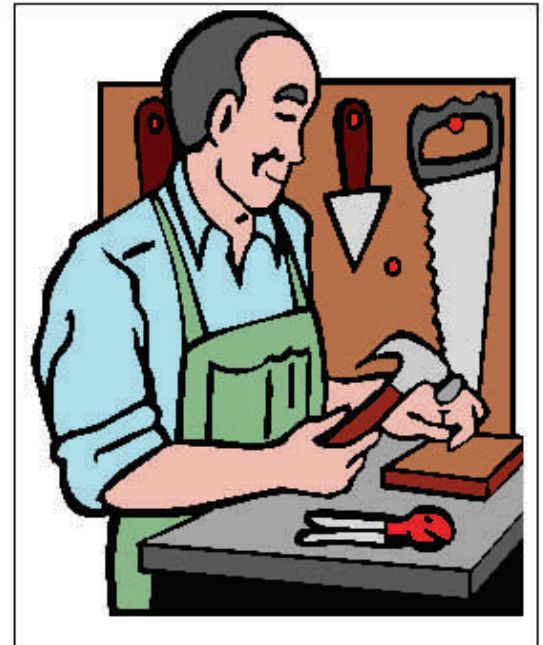

Next Scheduled Title V Initiative-CRM Candidate

Luna Community College's new Title V project has several different initiatives to develop and because of this, there are several different ad hoc committees that are created as those initiatives are identified on the timeline. For the month of December, Title V continued working on the SimLab initiative but also started on the CRM Candidate module. For this, the Admissions Committee was created to determine the direction and process to accomplish this directive. This committee includes: Director of Admissions, Moses Marquez, Director of Computer and IT Services, Rick Jaramillo, Registrar, Jonathan Ortiz, Lead Data Administrator, Denise Gibson, and Director of Planning, Development, and Institutional Research, John Tiernan along with Title V personnel.

This initiative allows Admissions to maximize use of the Jenzabar Admissions modules and allow students to streamline the process of their Application for Admission by giving them more online capabilities. During working hours, Admissions' staff will review these applications for final verification and processing and either merge with existing data, if it exists for the student, or allow the system to assign a new student identification number.

By implementing this new process, we should see a reduction in typographical errors and inaccurate data entry as long as the student entering the data takes care in entering their own information accurately. In order to properly implement this feature, the Admissions' module, as it currently exists, will have to be updated, thereby allowing for more functionality. This initiative is scheduled for pilot by fall 2013.

What is a SimLab? By Susan Olson Smith



Simulations are the wave of the future. scenarios for effective practice of diagnosis and treatment of a patient. It allows training in a wide range of healthcare settings, helping improve learners' competences and confidence. So control of the equipment is important.

During a recent visit to Tucson, I was fortunate to see a new simulation lab which actually had a "morgue" built into it. This is what they call their storage unit for the mannequins that aren't being used.

Each scenario is designed to operate in a variety of patient settings, including emergency departments, preoperative units, post anesthesia care units or PACU, surgical units, medical units, and outpatient units and takes about eight hours to write. The simulators are designed to enhance training realism, or true "simulation" in teams as to mimic real-life patient care in a controlled environment. Each instructor

has a list of goals or competencies that they want the students to learn or achieve.

The realistic features such as spontaneous breathing with visual chest rise and fall, lung, heart and voice sounds, blood pressure, pulse synchronized with heart rate all help the student immerse themselves in the simulation. These features help to facilitate learning of how to behave in a real-life emergency situation and not just in the classroom. Mistakes can be made on the mannequins and not real people but helps to build confidence in the students so they are more able to handle the real-life situations.
