## LCC’s philosophy on general education

Each degree program at Luna Community College contains an integrated core of general education requirements. These include but are not limited to courses in concentration areas of communication, mathematics, lab science, social and behavioral science, humanities, and fine arts. This core ensures that our graduates possess adequate literacy and general knowledge to function well in employment, to pursue additional education, and to participate in the cultural and political life of the community and society.

The following degree programs at LCC require integrated core of general education: criminal justice, early childhood multicultural education, general business, liberal arts, mass media communications, teacher education, alternative and sustainable energy, general engineering, life science, mathematics, physical science, business accounting, business administration, computer science, drafting technology, electronic engineering technology, equine science, fire science, general agriculture, military studies, nursing, office administration, video game design and development, and vocational/technical studies.

Additionally, students completing courses prescribed in a particular degree program will gain advanced

# Luna CC nursing students doing well on board exams

Over 90 percent of Luna Community College nursing graduates have passed the National Council Licensing Exam.

As of last week 14 of 15 or 93 percent all 2011 LCC graduates have passed. LCC paid or will pay for LCC graduates to take the exam if they take it prior to Aug. 31 .

“We are evaluated at the State Board of Nursing as a nursing program in New Mexico on first time takers of the RN National Council Licensing Exam (NCLEX-RN),” LCC Nursing Director Conni Reichert. “One of our major problems is that our students wait too long to take the exam so they have forgotten the information and generally fail. In widely published literature, if you wait 54 days from the time of eligibility you have a 77 percent chance of passing Boards.”

Some graduates wait a couple of years to take the exam.

“We have students now hoping to take it for the first time from

technical skills combined with a strong academic foundation that will enhance their transition to either the workforce or higher education. While these programs emphasize preparation for employment, many of the courses will transfer to a baccalaureate degree program.

classes of 2010 and 2009 that I know of. That always hurts us,” says Reichert. “We emphasize it over and over again on the need to take those Boards right away.”

The benchmark for the State Board of Nursing is to have 80 percent of students pass the first time. If they do not meet the 80 percent, then LCC as a school has to write reports, and present to the Board and get put on conditional or probation if it does not implement changes that bring the first time takers score up.

“I have written many reports and presented to the Board of Nursing and spoke at length to the site visitors for the Accreditation regarding this issue,” said Reichert. “It has always been difficult for us to maintain regular trends of reaching 80 percent or above.”

## **What are the benefits for LCC employees?**

The benefits for LCC employees are to improve overall health, you get an extra half an hour in your day to exercise, help relieve stress, and will have educated, experienced, motivated trainers to help work towards your goals and it's all for free!

## **How important is physical fitness in today's world?**

We all know what the importance of exercise can do for one's health. There are many benefits of exercise: controls weight, combats health conditions and diseases, improves mood, boost energy, promotes better sleep, increase in physical confidence, decreases stress level and exercise can be fun.

## **LCC Wellness Center? And what is the goal?**

Currently, we approximately have 120 staff members, out of 120 we have 18 employees that take advantage of what the Wellness Center has to offer. Some of these individuals take aerobics and others sign up for PE 112. The goal is to motivate our staff to incorporate exercise in their daily activity and to live a healthy life style. Our goal is to get more employees to participate and utilize the Wellness Center.

## **Any other comments?**

The wellness staff is committed to you for an hour during the time the classes are offered. Every participant will be given a fitness assessment. Everyone will have to complete proper paper work which is a health history questionnaire, a PAR-Q that follows American College of Sports Medicine guidelines. By filling out this paper work we will be able to screen anyone that has any health issues that may need a doctor's release form before they participate.

The Fitness Assessment will be given to everyone before the class starts. We will begin the class with teaching everyone how to take their target heart rate for their age, and resting heart rate starting at 60 percent-80 percent of their target heart rate. We will introduce and teach everyone how to use all cardio equipment, teach everyone how each machine works, what muscle you will be working on the machines, and how to use proper technique on each machine and exercise given. We will also teach you how to stretch each individual muscle.

We will start off the class with working the eleven major muscle groups and work on 20-30 minutes of cardio endurance for the first two-four weeks. As the semester progress we will break off with different programs that are tailored to each individual needs and goals. We are excited and looking forward to helping you reach your goals and making LCC staff healthy.
