Luna to offer passenger bus training program

Luna Community College will begin offering a bus training program beginning in January. The bus training program is in addition to the CDL program currently offered.

"The passenger bus training program will enable students to obtain employment with any employer that requires a bus training endorsement," says Program Administrator Tracy Morales. "We hope to start mid-January of 2024. There is an ongoing need for all classes of commercial drivers in our local area, state and nation."
