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2016–2017 Dependent Verification Worksheet (V1)

Your 2016–2017 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law states that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you and your parents reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid office at Luna Community College. Our office may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact your financial aid administrator as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

B. Dependent Student Family Information

- Your parents' other children if your parents will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, or if the other children would be required to provide parental information if they were completing a FAFSA for 2016-2017.

C. Dependent Student's Income to be Verified

In most cases, for electronic filers, a **2015 IRS Tax Return Transcript** may be requested from the IRS within 2–3 weeks after the 2015 IRS income tax return has been accepted by the IRS. Generally, for filers of 2015 paper IRS income tax returns, the **2015 IRS Tax Return Transcript** may be requested within 8–11 weeks after the 2015 paper IRS income tax return has been received by the IRS.

Generally, for filers of 2015 paper IRS income tax returns, the **2015 IRS Tax Return Transcript** may be requested within 8–11 weeks after the 2015 paper IRS income tax return has been received by the IRS.

- Copies of the child support payment checks, money order receipts, or similar records of electronic payments having been made.

F. Receipt of SNAP Benefits
