Admission's Director Moses Marquez was in good spirits on Friday afternoon saying that he intends to come back and he wishes everyone a good start this fall.





If you have an online course, log into Blackboard as soon possible to get your computer configured to work with both Blackboard and Wimba. If you need additional support with taking an online course you may want to attend one of the scheduled student trainings.

For more information and support with an online course you may call LCC Distance Education Coordinator Larry Paiz at the LCC Distance Education Services Office at 505-454-5361, 505-426-5270 and/or via Blackboard e-mail. You may also contact Paiz at lpaliz@luna.edu.

Keep in mind that when the college says “online services”, these services are not just for students taking online courses. These services impact every student. Online services can be used by simply checking their mid-term and/or final grade. Also the Online Learning Management System (Blackboard) is not just used for online courses, it is also used with the traditional face-to-face courses; these are called web-enhanced courses.

Starting fall 2013, there will be a couple of “hybrid courses”—this is a combination of face-to-face and online students.

Students needing assistance with any of the above mentioned services can contact Larry Paiz.

There are two separate areas to the online system at Luna Community College, online student services and online courses.

Online student services consist of student systems and support for the student to get things done without having to physically come to the

campus. Some of those systems and services are:

- Online Admissions
- Online Registration
- Online Financial Aid Management
- Online Bill Payment
- Online Account Management (declare\change major, view unofficial transcript, view schedule)
- Grade Checking
- Remote Desktop Server

Online courses and student course support consists of the following systems and services:

- Instructor and student trainings in Blackboard, PLATO and Wimba
