Accelerate Your Path to a New Career

The Accelerate program grew out of a desire to create a highly professional and skilled workforce in Northern New Mexico. The initiative is led by partners including the Department of Energy, Regional Development Corporation, Los Alamos National Laboratory, and six Northern New Mexico colleges.

Here's how it helps LCC students:

ONE-ON-ONE ADVISING

Accelerate Advisor provides one-on-one advising and professional development assistance.

Gain confidence in your ability to discuss strengths, earn a scholarship, write a great résumé, or meet future employers.

COMMUNITY

Have an opportunity to bond with your peers thru events, class and workshops.

Twenty students are selected.

CATCH-UP IN MATH

In the summer students can take Math 095.

These classes include in-class tutor and are designed to make math approachable to anyone who has struggled with math anxiety.

The summer Math courses are paid for by Accelerate and students receive a participation stipend upon passing.

COMPENSATION

Accelerate offers students up to \$1,600 throughout the year to participate in workshops, fellowships (paid career related internships), and coaching/learning events with regional employers.

ELIGIBILITY

Students must be attending LCC, be eligible to work in the U.S., and be seeking an approved degree.

Students Must Also Answer “Yes” to One of the Following Questions:

- Are you Hispanic, Native American, or African American?
- Are you a first generation college student?
- Delayed start to college?
- Work more than 35 hours per week?
- Are you a single parent?
- Are you a GED recipient?
- Do you qualify for a Pell Grant?
- Are you an honorably discharged veteran?
