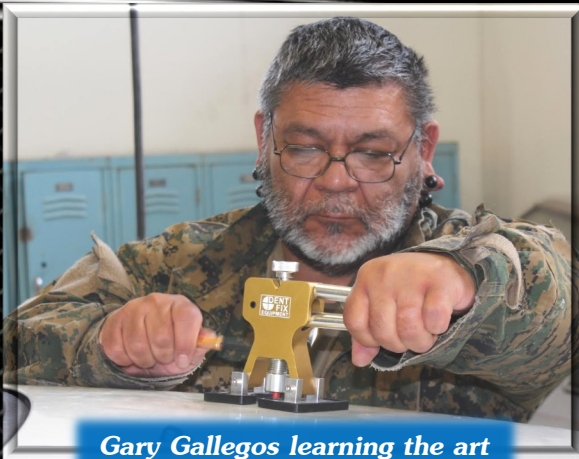


Auto Collision Repair Technology
