

Mark Dominguez joins Luna BOT representing District 2

Mark Dominguez is the newest member of the Luna Community College Board of Trustees. Dominguez replaces Michael Adams, who resigned on April 24, and will represent District 2 (San Miguel County, Las Vegas area). Luna Board of Trustees voted 4-2 in favor of Dominguez in a special meeting held on Wednesday afternoon. Dominguez shall serve until the next community college board election in November 2019, at which time he shall file for and be elected to fill the vacant position to serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

“I feel honored to be part of a team that can make rational decisions for students and get them ready for the next level of their education or career choice,” said Dominguez. “My family is living proof that Luna is a great school to begin your education. I have a son that graduated from Luna and it prepared him for Highlands

University where he earned a bachelor and master’s degree. My second son took dual credit courses during his junior and senior year in high school at Luna, and it prepared him for Highlands University. ”

Dominguez said he would like to see the College move forward.

“We need to work together and not worry about accreditation on a year-to-year basis,” said Dominguez. “It’s also very important to keep our accreditation for our employees. They should not have to be worried about employment. If Luna were to lose its accreditation, it would be devastating to Las Vegas and northern New Mexico. We need to continue to build confidence in our students, our employees and all our stakeholders.”

Dominguez, 47, is a 1989 graduate of West Las Vegas High School. He has three children. He will be officially sworn in during the Board's August meeting.
