Heavy Equipment Certifications

The Heavy Equipment Operation programs is comprehensive, industry developed, and offers nationally recognized certification. Candidates will be taught heavy equipment operations with a variety of heavy equipment and classroom instruction. Trainees successfully completing the National Center for Construction Education & Research (NCCER) Specialized Training will receive their **NCCER Certification Card** and be put on the national registry, which is a database maintained by the NCCER. It lists the names of individuals who have successfully completed any NCCER standardized construction and safety training by an accredited organization.

These programs are designed to give trainees the fundamental skills and knowledge needed to operate the following equipment listed below. In addition to operating heavy equipment, trainees will attend an OSHA 10-hour Occupational Safety and Health training course delivered by an authorized OSHA Outreach Trainer. Trainees successfully completing the course will receive an **OSHA-10 Hour Completion Card**. Funding is available through the **Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)** if eligibility requirements are met. WIOA is designed to help job seekers access employment, education, training, and support services to succeed in the labor market and to match employers with the skilled workers they need to compete in the global economy.
