Student Learning Outcomes Assessment (SLOA) is an on-going process at Luna Community College that takes place every semester with the ultimate goal of improving student learning. SLOA involves all faculty, to include online, dual credit and off site instruction. Academic Directors and staff are also involved with assessment of student learning.

The objectives of SLOA is to assist faculty with improving student learning through the implementation of LCC's Assessment Plan, submitting a written report for publication, and participating in end of the semester presentations. The following is LCC's principles of assessment and assessment plan.

LCC's Principles of Assessment

- Primary goal of Assessment is to continuously improve student learning at Luna Community College.
- Assessment is an extension to the needs and attention of students at Luna Community College.
- Assessment is ongoing at Luna Community College.
- Assessment activities must be useful to the individuals that conduct them, to programs, and to Luna Community College.

LCC's Assessment Plan

All course offerings, including degree and certificate programs, at Luna Community College are required to follow the four step assessment process. They include:

- A list of expected learning outcomes
- Assessment tools that directly measure those learning outcomes
- The results of the data, and
- How the data will be used to improve student learning
