In every heart, a mother's grace, A gentle smile, a warm embrace. For all they do, and all they give, In gratitude, we truly live.



Students can contact Sandra Sanchez via email at <u>sasanchez@luna.edu</u> or call 505-454-2526 (ext. 1816) to sign up for a test date. Please provide student ID number, phone number, and exam date in the email.

Students should create an account with ATI prior to the exam date (if you do not already have an account set up). To create an account, go to <u>www.atitesting.com</u> click on Create Account next to Log In. (Use Luna CC ADN for institution and estimated graduation date of 5/10/2027.) Please use your Luna email to set up ATI account.

On the day of your exam, please **arrive 10 minutes early*** to log in and purchase the exam. The cost of the exam is \$70. You will need to bring a debit/credit card to purchase the exam and a photo ID for identification verification. **No food or drinks** are permitted in the testing site. A calculator is available in ATI and the proctor will provide paper and pencils for use during the exam. All materials will be collected by the proctor before you leave the exam site.

*There will be no late admission into the testing area.
