Incomplete Applications will not be considered. It is your responsibility as the applicant to submit a complete, verifiable, and correct application package.

The AAUW Las Vegas scholarship committee may request you to meet with the committee as part of the application review process.

Candidates will be notified of the Selection Committee's decision no later than May 19, 2023.

Applicant Eligibility Qualifications for AAUW Las Vegas Scholarship:

- Female students who are either at least 24 years of age or with children if younger;
- Student must be attending the main Luna campus in Las Vegas for at least 2 in-person classes per semester;
- Students who will be in the second year of their Associate's degree program;
- Accumulated college GPA of at least 3.0; and
- Carrying at least 12 credit hours (or equivalent) per semester.

AAUW values and seeks diversity in all its endeavors. The Scholarship Committee's selection will be based solely on the review of the eligibility requirements as stated above. The award decision will not be influenced in any way on the basis of race, creed, sexual orientation, national origin, disability or class.
