 So far this year, Ortiz has 38 home runs, which ties a National Junior College Athletic Association record for one season. IT installing new hardware for Student Computer Labs

The 2023 New Mexico State Legislature provided a \$250,000 appropriation to Luna Community College for IT equipment to upgrade student use computer labs. The IT department performed an assessment of current computer labs and developed a plan to upgrade various labs throughout our main campus and satellites. The new equipment has been purchased and delivered, and our IT team is currently imaging computers and deploying the equipment to various buildings.

"It's been a long time since Luna has had new equipment in our student labs. It's very exciting to see the new labs going up with the new technology. Hopefully this will bring in a surge of new students to our STEM and Media programs" said Greg Salazar, LCC IT Director.

- Students should create an account with ATI prior to the exam date (if you do not already have an account set up). To create an account, go to www.atitesting.com click on Create Account next to Log In. (Use Luna CC ADN for institution and estimated graduation date of 5/11/2026.) Please use your Luna email to set up ATI account.
- On the day of your exam, please arrive 10 minutes early* to log in and purchase the exam. The cost of the exam is \$70. You will need to bring a debit/credit card to purchase the exam and a photo ID for identification verification. No food

or drinks are permitted in the testing site. A calculator is available in ATI and the proctor will provide paper and pencils for use during the exam. All materials will be collected by the proctor before you leave the exam site.

There will be no late admission into the testing area.
