Dental assistants perform a growing variety of duties in the dental field. It is important for All individuals interested in pursuing the Dental Assistant Certificate to be aware that the dental field does have some risk of occupational hazards. The nature of the occupation could involve contact with infectious diseases, including AIDS and Hepatitis. All students admitted to the program will receive proper instruction in standard precautions and use of personal protective equipment to reduce the risk of blood and body fluid exposures. Duties in dental assisting include but are not limited to: therapeutic communication, multicultural interaction, psychology, oral health, preventive techniques, nutrition, chairside instrumentation, infection control, equipment safety, equipment maintenance, dental office emergencies and pain/anxiety management. The NM State Board of Dental Health Care requires training and certification in Radiation Health & Safety, along with coronal polishing, topical fluoride and pit and fissure sealants. Most recent adopted is the Expanded Function Dental Assistant (EFDA). The assistant is responsible for all preparation of dental office procedures, chairside assisting, and reception activities. The demanding versatility requires a person dedicated to the profession and a commitment to function as a dental health care team member.
