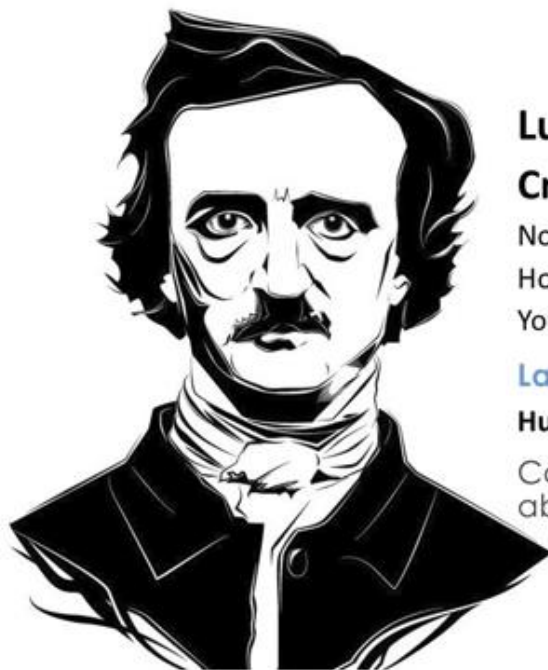
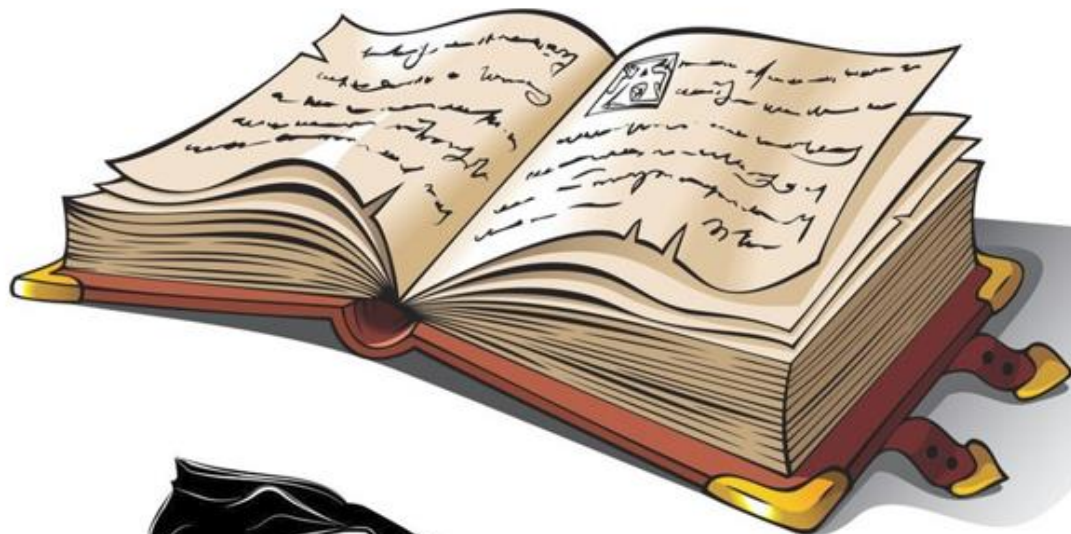
Ace Lab Hours
