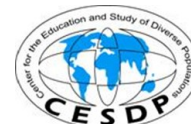

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Criteria for Submission– DEADLINE: APRIL 26, 2019

- Relevance to summit theme
- Innovative, applied, and advanced content
- Real world application
- Plan for audience interaction and critical thinking
- Potential for networking and sharing

Required review format

- A 150 word biography describing all presenters and co-presenters credentials, titles, and experience
- Three learning objectives
- A 200-300 word abstract including the purpose and content of your proposed session
- A high resolution photo of yourself for the summit program

- Name, phone contact and email of person submitting application
- Date application submitted:
- Title of presentation (15 words max): *All accepted presentations will follow a 20 minute panel presentation format*
