Understanding Student Mental Health: Strategies and Best Practices

In this 60-minute virtual session, faculty and staff at Luna Community College will learn about mental health first aid and best practices to support students, colleagues, and themselves. Topics covered will include an introduction to the signs and symptoms of common mental health issues, an overview of the resources available in-person/online, and strategies to support students. By the end of the session, participants will be better equipped to recognize signs of mental health distress among their students and respond appropriately.
