KRQE featured the Luna baseball team during a telecast on Tuesday, April 18. For the first time in team history, the Rough Riders sit in first place in the Region 9 South Division standings.

Luna introduced baseball in 2006.

The Luna baseball team took over first place in the Region 9 South Baseball standings after defeating Trinidad State 8-2, 11-1 and 13-8 at home over the weekend.

The Rough Riders are 13-14 in conference play; Trinidad State (12-14), Otero College (11-16) and Lamar Community College (9-18) are second, third and fourth in the standings, respectively. The Rough Riders are scheduled to play Lamar Community College on the road this weekend.


