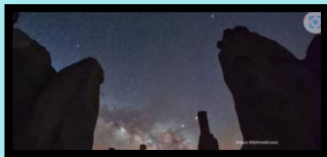
Saturday, August 31, 2024 at 10:00 am and 1:00 pm

Automotive Scholarship	Must be actively enrolled PT or FT in the Automotive Collision Repair/Automotive Technology Program	(3) \$500 Awards
Nursing Scholarship	Must be actively enrolled PT or FT in the Nursing Program	(4) \$500 Awards
General Scholarship	Must be actively enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits in any LCC Certificate or Degree Program	(8) \$500 Awards
Veterans Scholarship	Active Duty, Reserve, or Military Veteran enrolled PT or FT in any LCC certificate or Degree Program	(1) \$500 Award
