NURSING PROGRAM SELECTION CRITERIA – NURSING LEVEL 1 ENCLOSURE NUMBER ONE

In addition to Luna Community College Regular Admission policies, a Nursing Program applicant must also meet departmental criteria in order to become an eligible candidate. All applications will be screened in June 2023. The applicants will be notified by U.S. mail of their selection status. The notice will be mailed to the current address listed on the application for admission. Applicants are advised not to call regarding the status of their selection unless they have not received notification by **July 7, 2023.**

Eligible LCC Nursing Program candidates are objectively selected by rank order and admitted through an evaluative 100 Point Selection Scale. All eligible applicants compete for available slots for the program. The LCC Nursing Program Admission Committee will calculate the official scores and rank applicants based on total points. All decisions made by the committee are final and not subject to appeal. Official grade transcripts and transfer courses from other accredited institutions of higher education are necessary for the selection review and should be submitted by **June 9, 2023** as outlined on page one.

A total of 100 possible points can be earned from the following criteria:

1. PRE-ADMISSION EXAMINATION (50 Points)

Completion of The ATI-TEAS entrance exam is a requirement for admission. Up to 50 points can be gained in this category based on the actual score received.

2. CUMULATIVE GPA ON PRE-REQUISITE COURSES (40 Points)

A minimum of 2.75 GPA in pre-requisite courses is required for eligibility. The five pre-requisite courses used for GPA calculation are: Freshman Composition I, Human Anatomy and Physiology I w/Lab, Introduction to Psychology, Developmental Psychology and Basic Lab Science. A cumulative GPA of 4.0 will calculate to 40 points.

3. TEAS Score

A score of **58.7% or higher** on the ATI-TEAS exam is required in order to be considered for admission (no exceptions).

4. OTHER CRITERIA (10 Points)

There are 4 points (all or nothing) possible for 500 or more documented and verified hours of health care work experience within the last three years. Proof provided as a letter on company letter head from employer.

A total of 2 points each (up to 6 points possible) for completion of the following additional courses and passing with a B or higher: Medical Terminology (AH113), Human Nutrition (NUTR2110), and/or Microbiology (BIOL2305).
