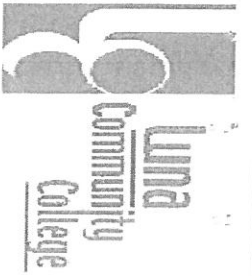

New Mexico Highlands University		<p>a. Program Updates</p> <p>Jeanne Flood said that that there are One hundred and nine (109) student's enrolled. There was difficulty in online admission transition. A bit of drop off, however, admission increased for Spring 2020. The transition is working better, glitches are repaired. Usually, the Spring semester is smaller than Fall. Presently, twenty-five to thirty (25-30) students have enrolled for Spring 2020. Working on starting a new program placed RP SP (Special Fund) through Legislature and NM government. Seems to be approved in support of the nursing request for fund to start a DMT</p>		<p>Jeanne and Helene are meeting with Santa Fe Community College to have a joint pathway so students have the opportunity to attend New Mexico Highlands University.</p>

		<p>Maxine said that Luna Community College is a MNNEC school. We have to have a BSN option for students. There is discussion in NMMEC and task force for support in getting a BSN Degree. At LCC, a pre-nursing student is advised by Vanessa Torres, Student Advisor. If a student shows interest in BSN program they meet with Sierra Fernandez, Student Success Coach. We are moving forward, the State of New Mexico is on the cutting edge of nursing education. MNNEC curricula has been written in journals and presented nationally at conferences. New Mexico is becoming a model for the rest of the country as far as type of curriculum goes.</p>

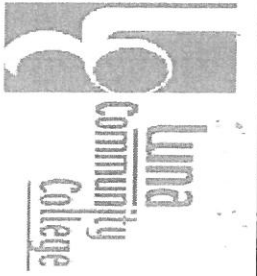

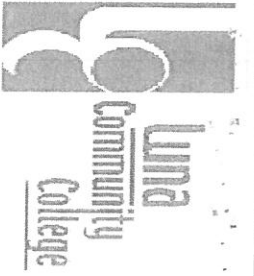
