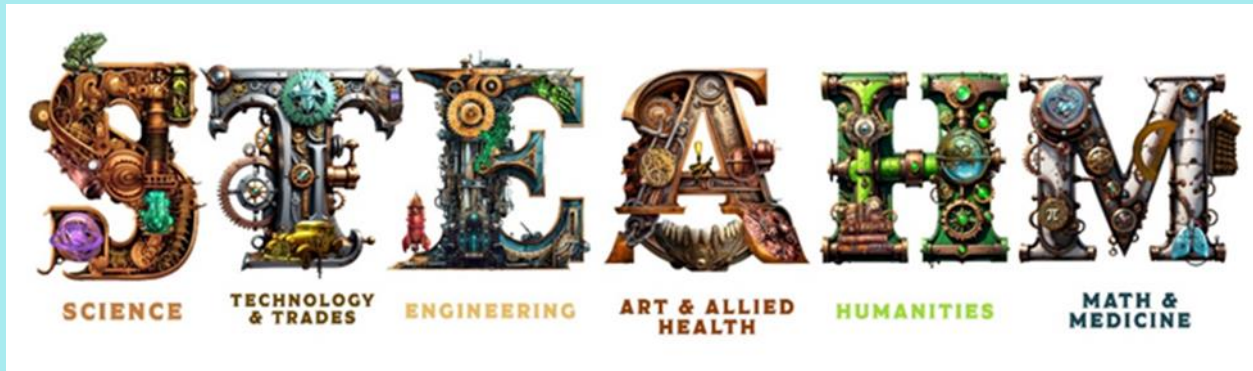

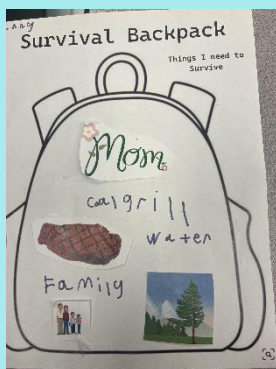


Santa Rosa:
