Automotive Technology

Learn or upgrade your skills in every aspect of automotive maintenance, performance and repair. Learn chassis, electrical, fuel, climate control, drive train systems and engine performance and repair.

The program follows ASE and NATEF curriculum standards. Earn a certificate and become eligible to take the ASE certification test.



► COVID precautions: Online only at this time

Auto Collision Repair Technology

Learn all aspects of auto body repair, metalworking, plastic repair, panel replacement, restoration, refinishing, basic structural repair, damage estimating, shop management and more.

The program follows ASE and NATEF curriculum standards. Earn a certificate and become eligible to take the ASE certification test.



► COVID precautions: Use of PPE, distancing; limited class sizes on campus.

Barbering

Learn the basic skills, safety judgments, proper work habits and desirable attitudes to attain competencies sought in entry-level positions in barbering or related career fields.

Earn a certificate and be eligible to take the state licensure exam.



► COVID precautions: Combination of distance and online learning only.

Cosmetology

Learn sterilization, sanitization, bacteriology, shampoo, rinses, scalp treatments, chemical rearranging, perms and relaxers, hairstyling, hair coloring, bleaching, highlighting, hair cutting, facials, manicuring, pedicuring, salon management and retail sales.

Earn a certificate and become eligible to take the state licensure exam.



► COVID precautions: Combination of distance and online learning only.

Commercial Driver's License

Learn how to safely operate and maintain commercial and oversized vehicles. A combination of theory and lab practice is used in CDL training, which takes less than three months to complete.

Complete the training and become eligible to take the state licensure exam. Financial assistance may be available through the Northern Area Workforce Development Board.



► COVID precautions: Limited class sizes, social distancing, etc., on site.

Welding Technology

Learn entry-level job skills in all phases of the welding industry or acquire additional training. Emphasis is on skills used in construction.

Earn a certificate and prepare for state certification through the American Welders Society (AWS).



► COVID precautions: Limited class sizes; PPE, social distancing required on site.

Study a little longer for a degree.

Completion of certificates in Automotive Technology, Auto Collision Repair Technology, Barbering, Cosmetology and Welding may be applied toward an Associate of Applied Science in Career & Technical Education.
