
New board members are needed.

It is difficult to get in contact with the VA rep for the school. My documents have always been submitted late and I receive my money late to pay for school.


I wish the school offered more classes in the evening for those students that work full time jobs it slows down our pursuit of degrees when we can't take the classes that we need



What academic program are you currently enrolled in?



How do you primarily take classes at your school?





What is your current age?





What is your gender?




