Dental Assisting

There is new equipment in dental assisting including a panoramic machine, x-ray processing equipment, and intraoral cameras.

A panoramic machine takes one image of the entire mouth--students can practice looking for abnormal things like cancer or impacted wisdom teeth. The intraoral cameras allow us to show patients what's going on in their mouths. And the new digital x-ray equipment uses a thinner sensor to take x-rays; this can be more comfortable for the patient. We also have a new Statim sterilizer, which will update the two old ones we have.

All of this equipment with help better prepare our dental assisting students for the field.
