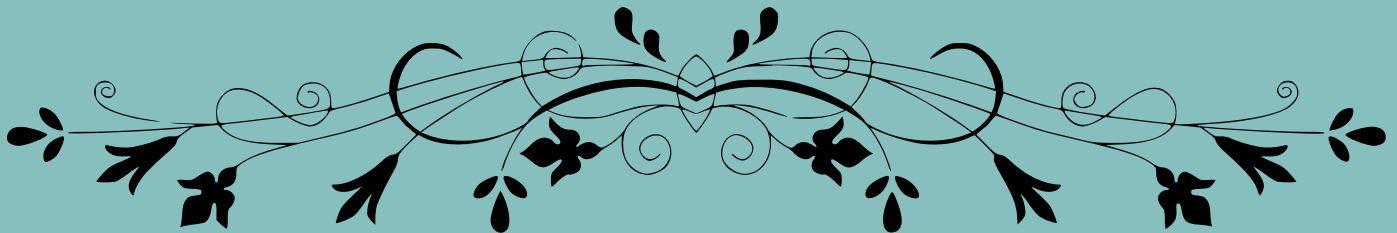

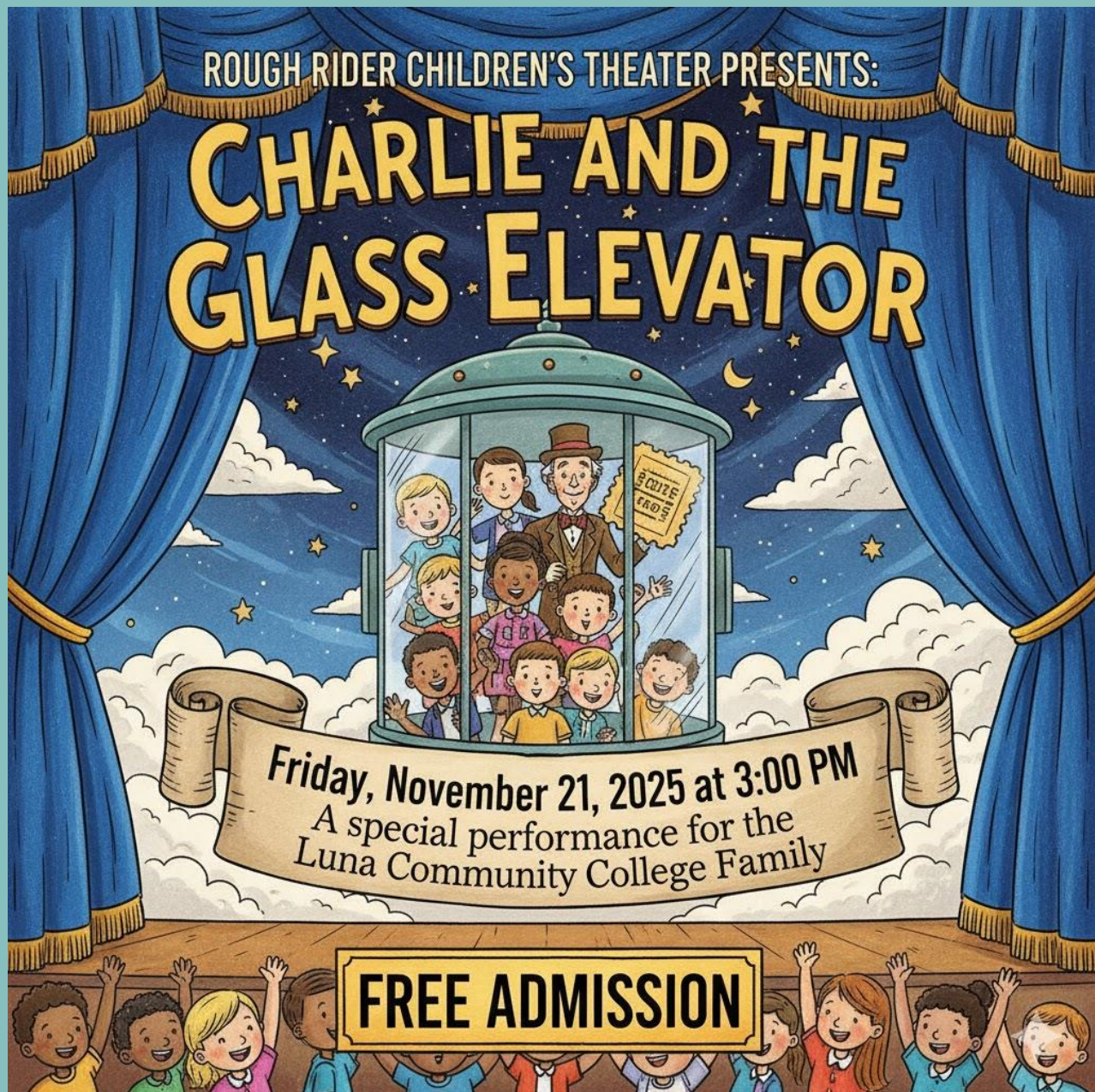

Passing TEAS score is 58.7% overall or higher. There are 30 slots available for qualified applicants for admission in Fall 2026.

Please provide student ID number, phone number, and exam date in the e-mail.

You have up to three attempts per academic year to pass the exam; the fee for each attempt is \$70.

You're advised to set up an account with ATI prior to the exam date; go to atitesting.com, click on Create Account. Use Luna CC ADN for institution, with estimated graduation date of 5/13/2028

Nursing Program Admission Process



1. Get admitted to LCC (See Admission's Office for process, call 505-454-5312, or visit our website at Luna.edu).
2. Obtain advisement at the LCC Student Success Center, call 505-454-5343 or 505-454-2549.
3. Register for and pass all prerequisite courses with a C or better (ensure all official transcripts are at the LCC registrar's office with any prior coursework):
 - a. BIOL110/L or BIOL140/L, or CHEM120/L or CHEM215/L: General Lab Science (Chemistry, Biology or Biology for Health Sciences) (4 credits) *
 - b. BIOL2210/L Human Anatomy & Physiology 1 w/Lab (4 credits) *
 - c. BIOL2225/L** Human Anatomy & Physiology 2 w/Lab (4 credits)
 - d. BIOL2505** Pathophysiology (4 credits)
 - e. ENGL1110 Composition 1 (3 credits) *
 - f. ENGL1120** Composition 2 (3 credits)
 - g. PSYC1110 Introduction to Psychology (3 credits) *
 - h. PSYC2120 Developmental Psychology (3 credits) *
 - i. MATH1350** Statistics (3 credits)

*Courses count toward minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75

** Up to 2 of these courses may be taken in level 1 and must be passed with a C or better to continue in the Nursing Program: BIOL2225-L, BIOL2505, ENGL1120, MATH1350.

 - All science courses must be taken within 7 years of application submission.
 - Student must be 18 years of age for application submission.
4. Schedule and take the ATI-TEAS admission examination (see Sandra Sanchez, Student Services Specialist-Nursing or call 505-454-2526).
About the ATI-TEAS Exam:
 - a. The ATI-TEAS Exam is proctored on campus. You are permitted three attempts per academic year to pass the exam.
 - b. Test results are valid for the current academic year.
 - c. The cost is \$70.00 per attempt.
 - d. Arrive at least ten minutes early for the test and only bring a valid photo ID and credit/debit card to purchase exam online prior to start of exam.
 - e. Must meet minimum overall TEAS exam score of 58.7% or higher to be considered.
 - f. It is recommended that the student obtain and study the Official ATI TEAS Study Manual (ISBN # 978-1565332393).
5. Obtain a nursing admission packet from the Nursing Department via the Luna Community College website.
6. Submit a completed packet on or prior to the deadline, the **first Friday in June** to the Nursing Department.
7. Selections from the applicant pool will occur during the summer by the selection committee and students will be notified by mail. All decisions made by the selection committee are final.
8. 30 spaces are available each fall semester and students are selected by numerical ranking determined by the following:
 - a. 50 points available for overall ATI-TEAS score
 - b. 40 points available for course-block cumulative GPA (see number 3 above for course-block courses)
 - c. 10 points based on institutional choice (4 points – 500 documented/verified hours of healthcare work experience within the last 3 years. 6 points possible for taking and passing with a B or better: Medical Terminology, Nutrition, and/or Microbiology – 2 points awarded per course).

Line-Up - 2:00 PM - In front of Family Dollar (Mora, NM)

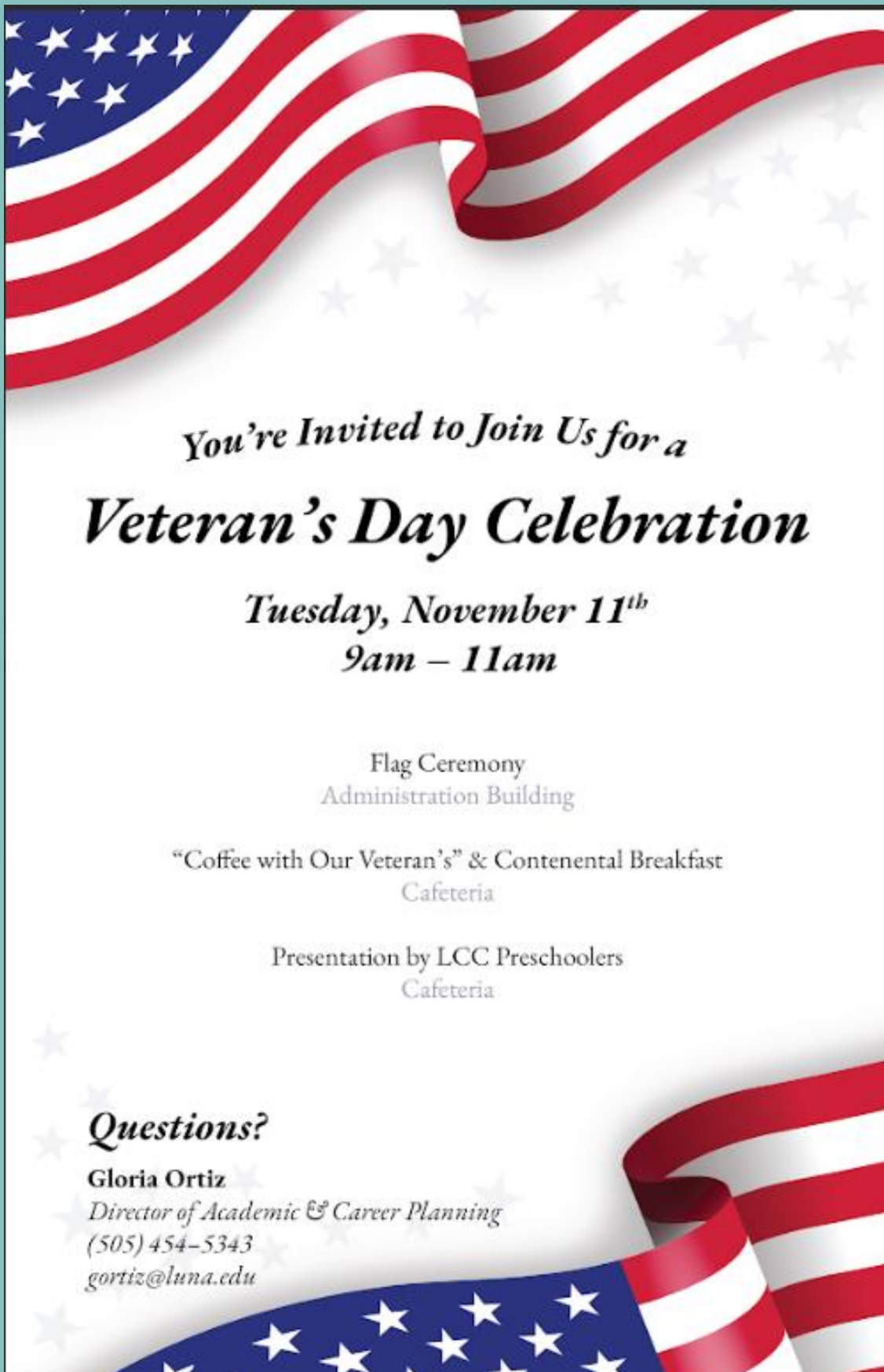

Board Member Takes College Spirit to the Sky!

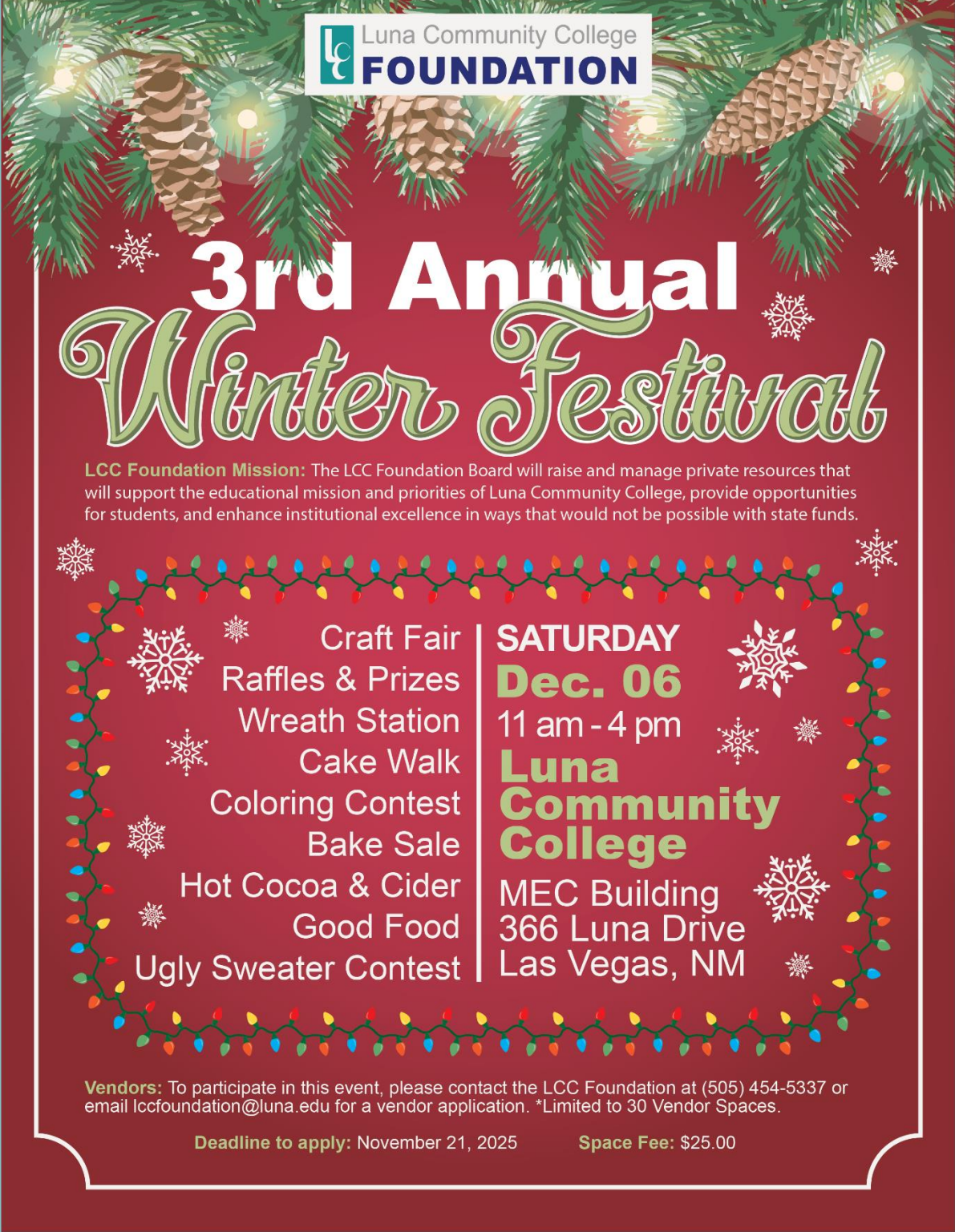

TimelyCare FAQ



What is TimelyCare?

TimelyCare is a virtual health and well-being platform available 24/7 for Luna Community College students.

Who can use TimelyCare?

Any enrolled Luna Community College student can use TimelyCare.

How do I log in?

Go to timelycare.com/Luna or download the TimelyCare app to access care.

How much does a visit cost?

There is no cost to enrolled Luna Community College students.

I already have insurance. How does TimelyCare benefit me?

With TimelyCare, you will have free, 24/7 access to providers from anywhere in the United States, regardless of your insurance status. So, you'll never have to spend time or money on care, whether you're on or off campus.

Can I get a prescription?

Yes, if the provider deems it clinically appropriate.

What can I be treated for?

TimelyCare's providers can offer support for a wide range of common concerns, and after talking to you, they will decide on the best course of treatment.

What services are available?

- **MedicalNow:** On-demand support for common health issues, including cold, flu, and allergies.
- **TalkNow:** 24/7, on-demand emotional support to talk about anything, including anxiety, relationships, depression, and school-related stressors.
- **Scheduled Medical:** Choose the day, time, and medical provider that best works for you.
- **Scheduled Counseling:** Choose the day, time, and mental health provider that works best for you. (6 visits per year)
- **Health Coaching:** Develop healthy lifestyle behaviors for nutrition, sleep habits, time management, and mindfulness.
- **Self-Care Content:** Visit the Self-Care tab for 24/7 access to tools and resources, such as meditation and yoga sessions, helpful videos, and short articles from experts.
- **Basic Needs Support:** Get connected to free or reduced-cost community resources, including food and housing assistance, transit support, childcare, and finances.
