Nursing Program Selection Criteria – Nursing Level 1 ENCLOSURE NUMBER ONE

In addition to Luna Community College Regular Admission policies, a Nursing Program applicant must also meet departmental criteria in order to become an eligible candidate. All applications will be screened in June 2019. The applicants will be notified by U.S. mail of their selection status. The notice will be mailed to the current address listed on the application for admission. Applicants are advised not to call regarding the status of their selection unless they have not received notification by **the first week of July 15, 2020.**

Eligible LCC Nursing Program candidates are objectively selected by rank order and admitted through an evaluative 100 Point Selection Scale. All eligible applicants compete for available slots for the program. The LCC Nursing Program Admission Committee will calculate the official scores and rank applicants based on total points. All decisions made by the committee are final and not subject to appeal. Official grade transcripts and transfer courses from other accredited institutions of higher education are necessary for the selection review and should be submitted by **June 19, 2020** as outlined on page one.

A total of 100 possible points can be earned from the following criteria:

1. <u>PRE-ADMISSION EXAMINATION</u> (50 Points)

Completion of The ATI-TEAS entrance exam is a requirement for admission. Up to 50 points can be gained in this category based on the actual score received.

2. CUMULATIVE GPA ON PRE-REQUISITE COURSES (40 Points)

A minimum of 2.75 GPA in pre-requisite courses is required for eligibility. The first five pre-requisite courses used for GPA calculation are listed on Enclosure Number Seven. Example: A cumulative GPA of 4.0 will calculate to 40 points.

3. OTHER CRITERIA (10 Points)

These minimum scores on the ATI-TEAS are required in order to be considered for admission: **Reading 72.4**, **Math 68.6**, **and Science 57.2**. Up to 10 points can be gained in this category based on the actual scores received.

- 4. The ATI-TEAS Exam may only be attempted three times each (academic) year and results are only valid for the current (academic) year.
- 5. If the ATI-TEAS Exam is taken more than once, the highest score per section will be used to calculate the point value.
