## Heavy Equipment (Simulator Based) Training Program Enrollment Process (Certificate – non-degree)

- **STEP 1** Contact Heavy Equipment (HE)/Ready to Work personnel to schedule appointment by phone or in person to begin the process. We are located in the General Studies building on the Luna campus (take second left off 144 at the top of the hill and the General Studies building is on the left after the roundabout).

- STEP 2 Get admitted to Luna Community College (https://luna.edu/admissions).
  - Apply by paper or online at <a href="https://luna.edu/application">https://luna.edu/application</a> ("Apply Now")
  - You will receive a username, student email address, and Student ID number
- **STEP 3** Seek financial assistance, if needed. The Heavy Equipment Simulator Program does not qualify for financial aid thru FAFSA.
  - Ask whether your current employer will pay for your training/fees if it will help in your job.
  - Inquire with NM Workforce Connection and/or the NM Help office
  - Inquire with the NM DVR (Division of Vocational Rehabilitation office)
  - Or set up payment plan (see step 6) with Luna CC
- **STEP 4** Register for Heavy Equipment Simulator classes directly through the CDL/Heavy Equipment Department.

**Important Notes**: If available, 200 level courses are taught in the field. Student must have successfully completed the 100 level training for the same equipment. Student should be prepared for varying weather issues (cold/hot/windy) and inclement weather (wear/bring appropriate clothing, bottled water, snacks. Wear appropriate footwear (no sandals/loose slip on shoes) No alcohol/drugs/guns, knives or other weapons/ammo/hazardous items are allowed in our training equipment or classrooms.

## **STEP 5** OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Student must be able to pass the DOT physical and drug test requirements in order to take the 200 level HE courses. CDL/HE dept has a list of approved providers.
