

**Job Title:** Post-Fire Watershed Restoration Field Crew Member

**Job Description:** HPWA is hiring 4 crew members to serve on a seasonal field work crew. All members should have the ability to do hard physical work needed for building log and rock structures for erosion control, seeding, mulching, and other restoration in a variety of outdoor terrains and weather. The ability to hike in and out of remote job sites and carry equipment and supplies is required.

- Work period - May 26, 2025 – August 29, 2025 (tentative)
- Full-time – 40 hours/week
- Crew Member Wage - \$20/hour

Crew members should be able to take instruction from crew leader and assist other crew members in accomplishing restoration or land management projects.

A calculator is available in ATI and the proctor will provide paper and pencils for use during the exam. All materials will be collected by the proctor before you leave the exam site.
