How to Request Swag from Admissions and Recruitment Department: A Step-by-Step Guide

This guide will help you effectively request items from any the Admissions and Recruitment Department, ensuring a smooth and efficient process.

Step 1: Gather All the Details Before You Start

Being prepared saves time! Collect the following information:

- **Item Details:**
 - **Exact Items:** Be precise! (e.g., "gradient mugs, mini notebooks, clear and teal water bottles).
 - **Quantity:** How many do you need?
- **Why You Need It (Justification):**
 - **Reason:** Clearly explain *why* you need the item and how it will be used.
- **When You Need It (Urgency):**
 - **Required By Date:** Provide a realistic date.
 - **Urgency Explanation:** If it's urgent, explain why and what the impact will be if there's a delay.

Step 3: Submit Your Request

Use the LCC Swag Request Form.

- **Online Request System:**
 - Fill out *every field* completely and accurately.

Step 4: Review & Follow Up

- **Double-Check:** Before submitting, **review everything** for accuracy, completeness, and clarity.
- **Be Patient:** Allow a reasonable amount of time before following up.
- **Professional Follow-Up:** If you haven't heard back by the expected date, send a polite follow-up, referencing your original request or details.

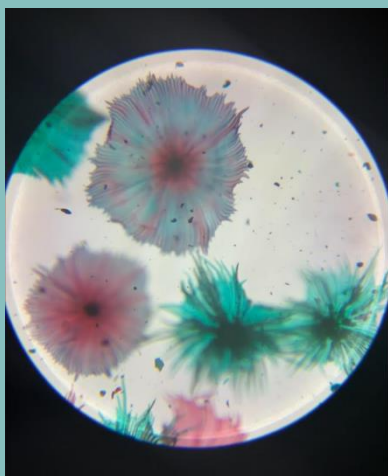
