  - a. Jessica-should panel become a standing committee in FS or in the Retention & Completion Committee? Kenny-Recommended that panel be a committee under Retention & Completion and if that can't take place, then FS will have it as one of their committees. Jessica-Suggested that this also be further discussed with Betsy, who is Panel facilitator.
- E. Goals for FS, for remainder of 2017/2018 school year—Need to fill all senator positions
  - a. Kenny discussed that as per bi laws, no more elections could take place, but there were positions that needed to be filled including Allied health & Humanities Senators. Jessica-Suggested that members selfnominate. Jackie-Self nominated for Allied Health Sciences and Nursing Senator. Sierra-Self nominated for Associate Members Senator. Geno-This will hurt students because they will see higher level courses and will not attempt to complete certificate. Sherry- Do higher level classes actually serve voc. Students? Can just change courses from s/u to letter grade.
