TimelyCare FAQ



What is TimelyCare?

TimelyCare is a virtual health and well-being platform available 24/7 for Luna Community College students.

Who can use TimelyCare?

Any enrolled Luna Community College student can use TimelyCare.

How do I log in?

Go to timelycare.com/Luna or download the TimelyCare app to access care.

How much does a visit cost?

There is no cost to enrolled Luna Community College students.

I already have insurance. How does TimelyCare benefit me?

With TimelyCare, you will have free, 24/7 access to providers from anywhere in the United States, regardless of your insurance status. So, you'll never have to spend time or money on care, whether you're on or off campus.

Can I get a prescription?

Yes, if the provider deems it clinically appropriate.

What can I be treated for?

TimelyCare's providers can offer support for a wide range of common concerns, and after talking to you, they will decide on the best course of treatment.

What services are available?

- **MedicalNow:** On-demand support for common health issues, including cold, flu, and allergies.
- **TalkNow:** 24/7, on-demand emotional support to talk about anything, including anxiety, relationships, depression, and school-related stressors.
- **Scheduled Medical:** Choose the day, time, and medical provider that best works for you.
- **Scheduled Counseling:** Choose the day, time, and mental health provider that works best for you. (6 visits per year)
- **Health Coaching:** Develop healthy lifestyle behaviors for nutrition, sleep habits, time management, and mindfulness.
- **Self-Care Content:** Visit the Self-Care tab for 24/7 access to tools and resources, such as meditation and yoga sessions, helpful videos, and short articles from experts.
- **Basic Needs Support:** Get connected to free or reduced-cost community resources, including food and housing assistance, transit support, childcare, and finances.

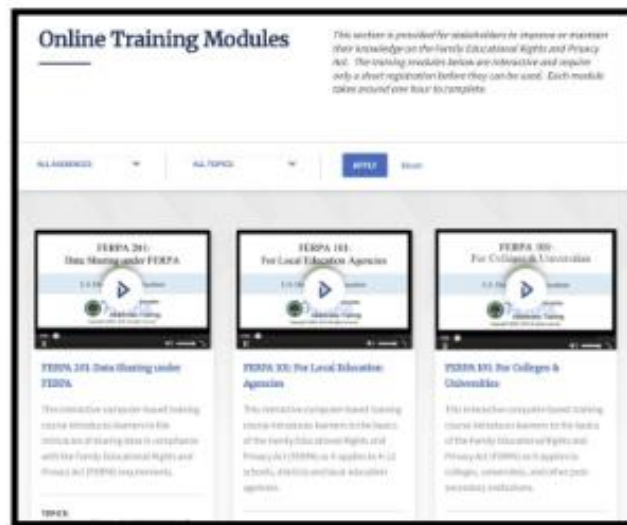

FERPA Training Instructions Academic Year 2025-2026

All LCC Staff, Faculty and Student Workers are required to complete FERPA Training annually. Please follow the steps below to complete your FERPA Training requirements for the academic year. Supervisors of Student Workers are required to share this information with them. Training is required to be completed by all Staff, Faculty and Student Workers by **September 30, 2025**.

1. Go to <https://studentprivacy.ed.gov/content/online-training-modules> to find the appropriate training module.

3. On the training page click on "Click here to access this course"

FERPA 101: For Colleges & Universities

This online training course was developed by the Student Privacy Policy Office's Privacy Technical Assistance Center as an introduction to the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), and its requirements relating to the privacy and security of Personally Identifiable Information (PII) in student records. This course addresses FERPA basics, explores requirements for the protection of student records for colleges, universities, and other postsecondary institutions, addresses who may and may not access student records, when those records may be shared, and discusses several of the applicable exceptions to the FERPA requirement for consent.

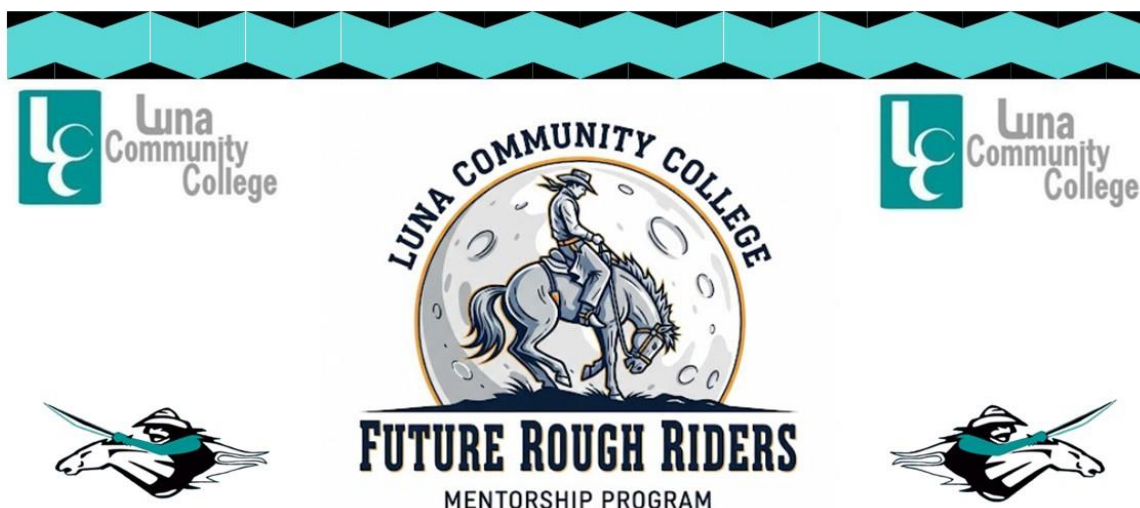
